



Grasshopper and the Ants




So, while the Ants are working hard getting ready for the hard months of winter, the Grasshopper was playing and having a good time all summer.




Soon winter arrives and the grasshopper stopped playing, singing and dancing. He got cold, hungry and began to worry what he was going to do.


