SOCIAL DISTANCING

CLOSE CONTACT RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

In light of recent events due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic, the Choctaw Public Health Services is strongly recommending changes to Choctaw activities such as Close Contact Recreational Activities to adhere to the Social Distancing recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Executive Order and State of Emergency Proclamation declared by Chief Ben. These prevention methods are to help alleviate the transmission of the coronavirus during this difficult time.

RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

- Following the social distancing of 6 feet apart from individuals not in household.
- Consider groups of 10 or less in attendance must maintain or proper social distancing defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention as staying six feet apart.
- Refrain from using any recreational courts, playgrounds, or fields while the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians is under Executive Order and State of Emergency Proclamation.
