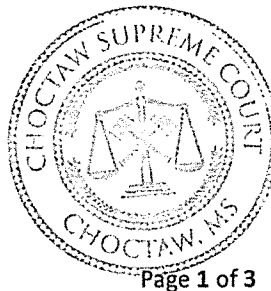
**ORDER DISMISSING CRIMINAL APPEAL FOR CR# 2021-742 & 2022-240**

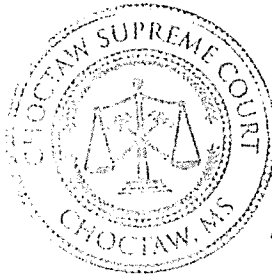
